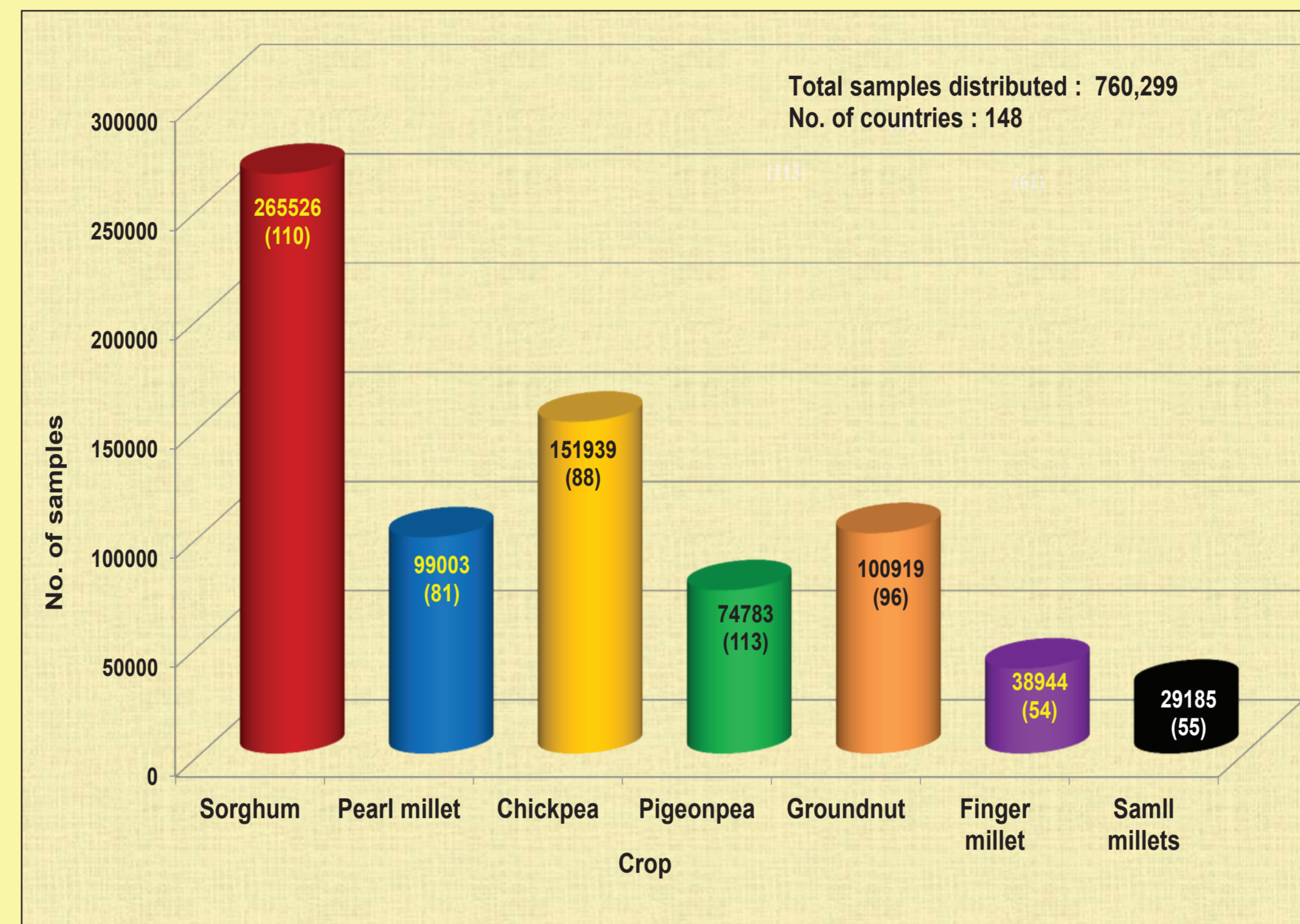
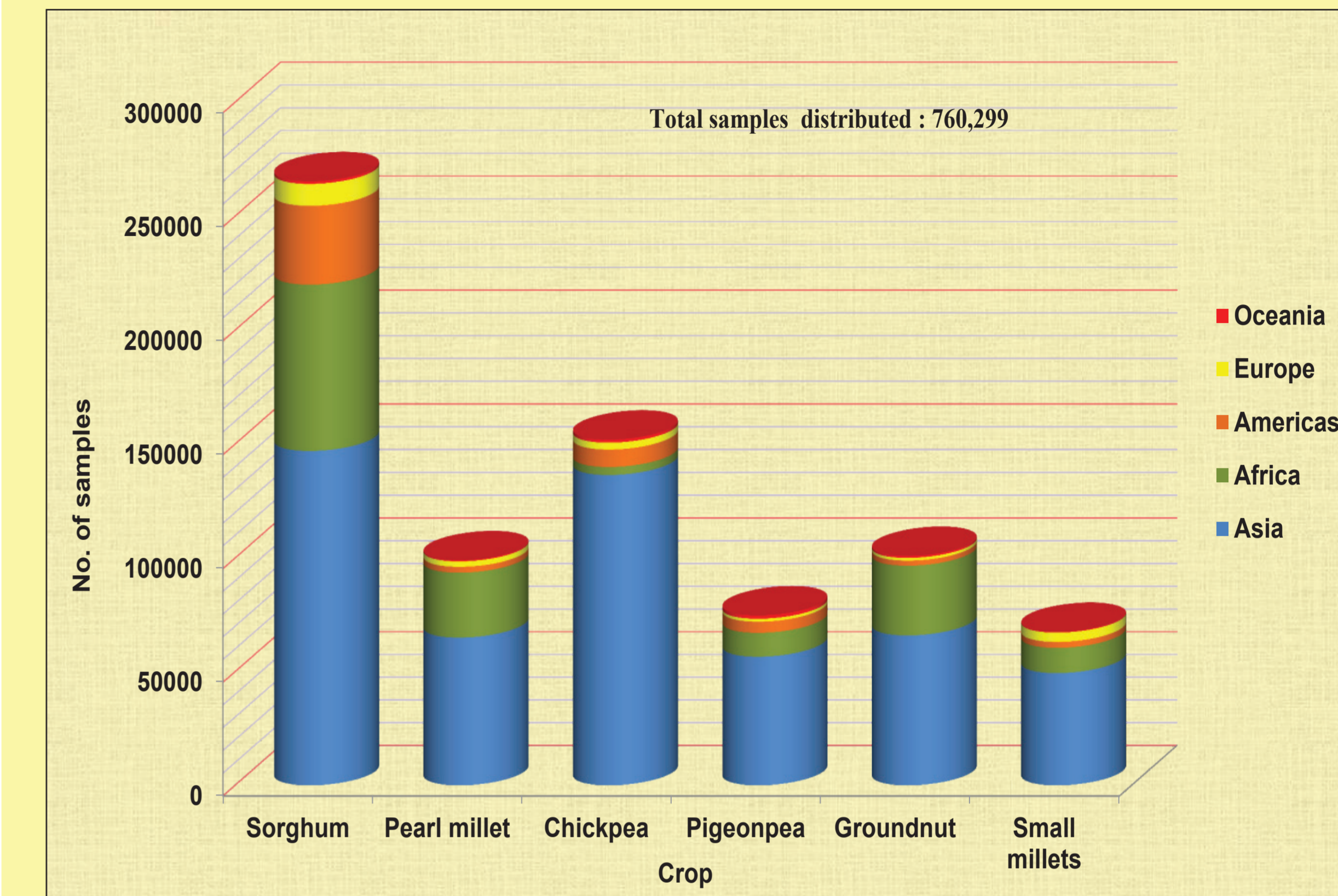


Germplasm Distribution

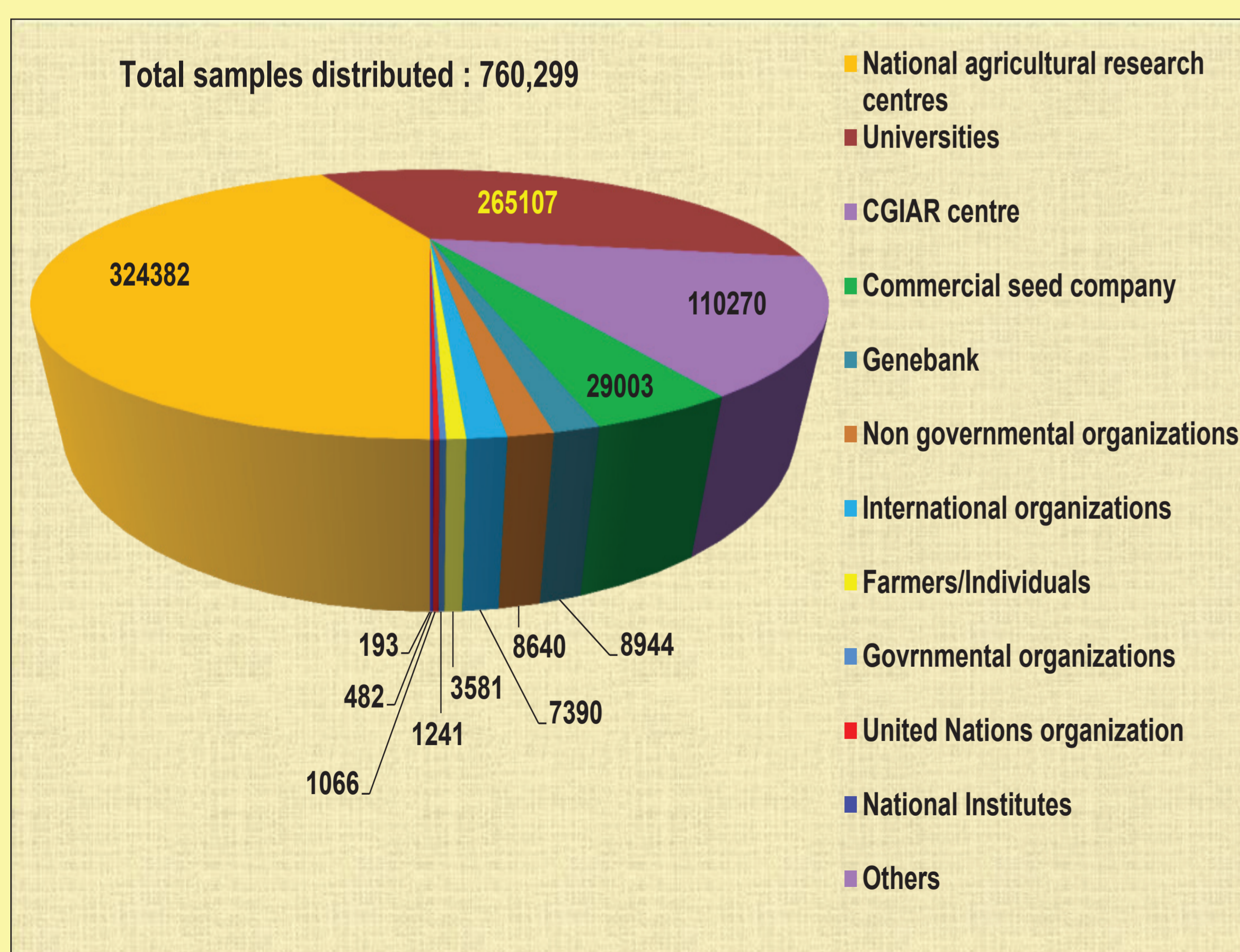
- ❖ Germplasm samples of all accessions under the multilateral system (MLS) are supplied free of cost for research and development, following the Standard Material Transfer Agreement (SMTA) of ITPGRFA.
- ❖ Germplasm order forms are used for internal distribution.
- ❖ Germplasm supplied to researchers outside India is subjected to Indian Plant Quarantine regulations.
- ❖ About 3-6 g of cultivated cereals, 50-100 seeds of legumes and 25 seeds of wild relatives, per accession are supplied
- ❖ About 1.46 million samples of germplasm have been distributed to scientists within ICRISAT and in 148 countries, including the distribution from regional genebanks.



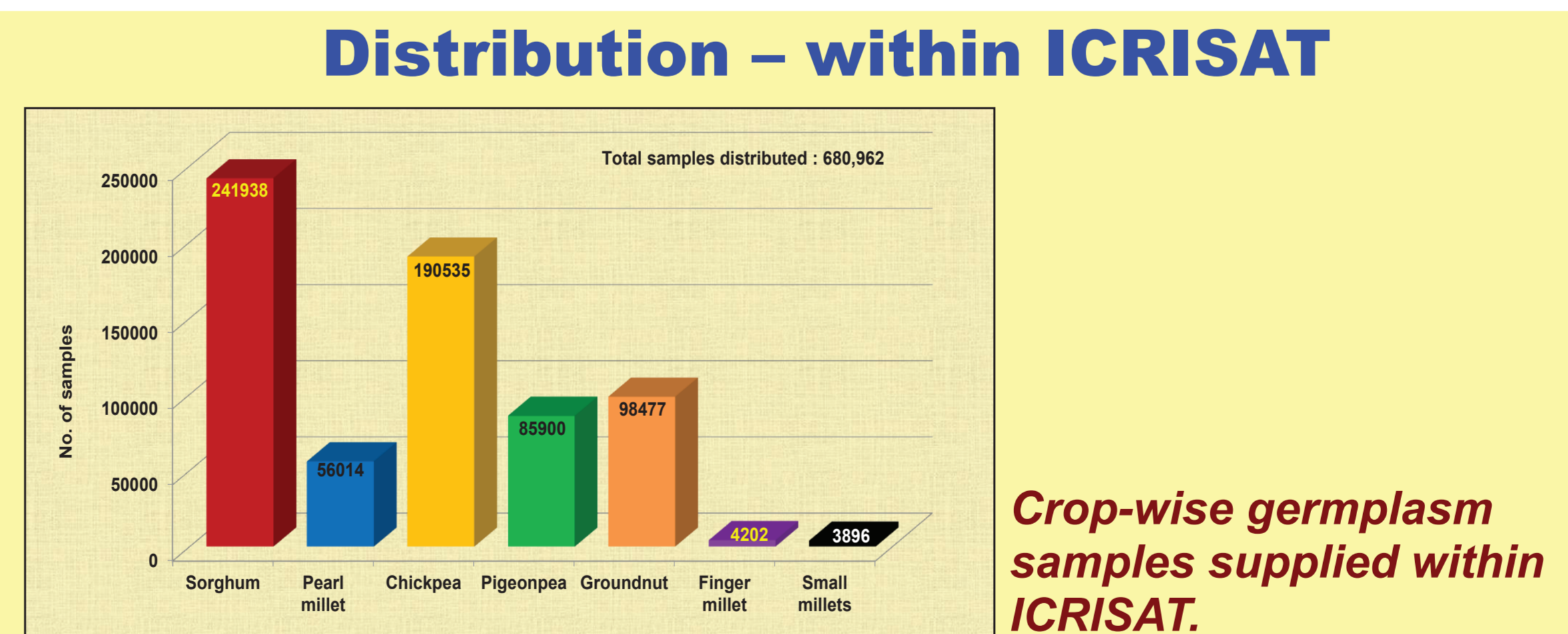
Crop-wise germplasm samples distributed from the ICRISAT genebank.



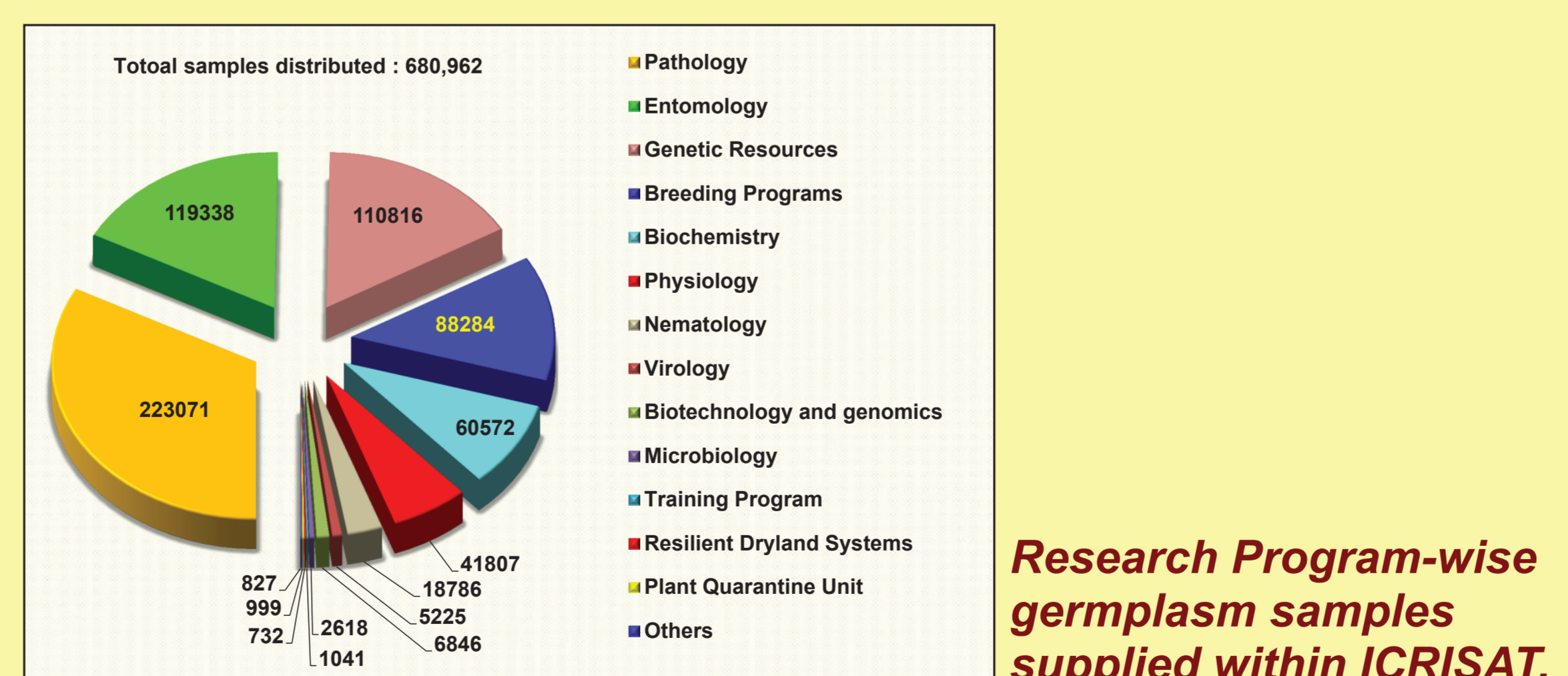
Region-wise germplasm samples supplied from the ICRISAT genebank.



Germplasm samples supplied to various user organizations.



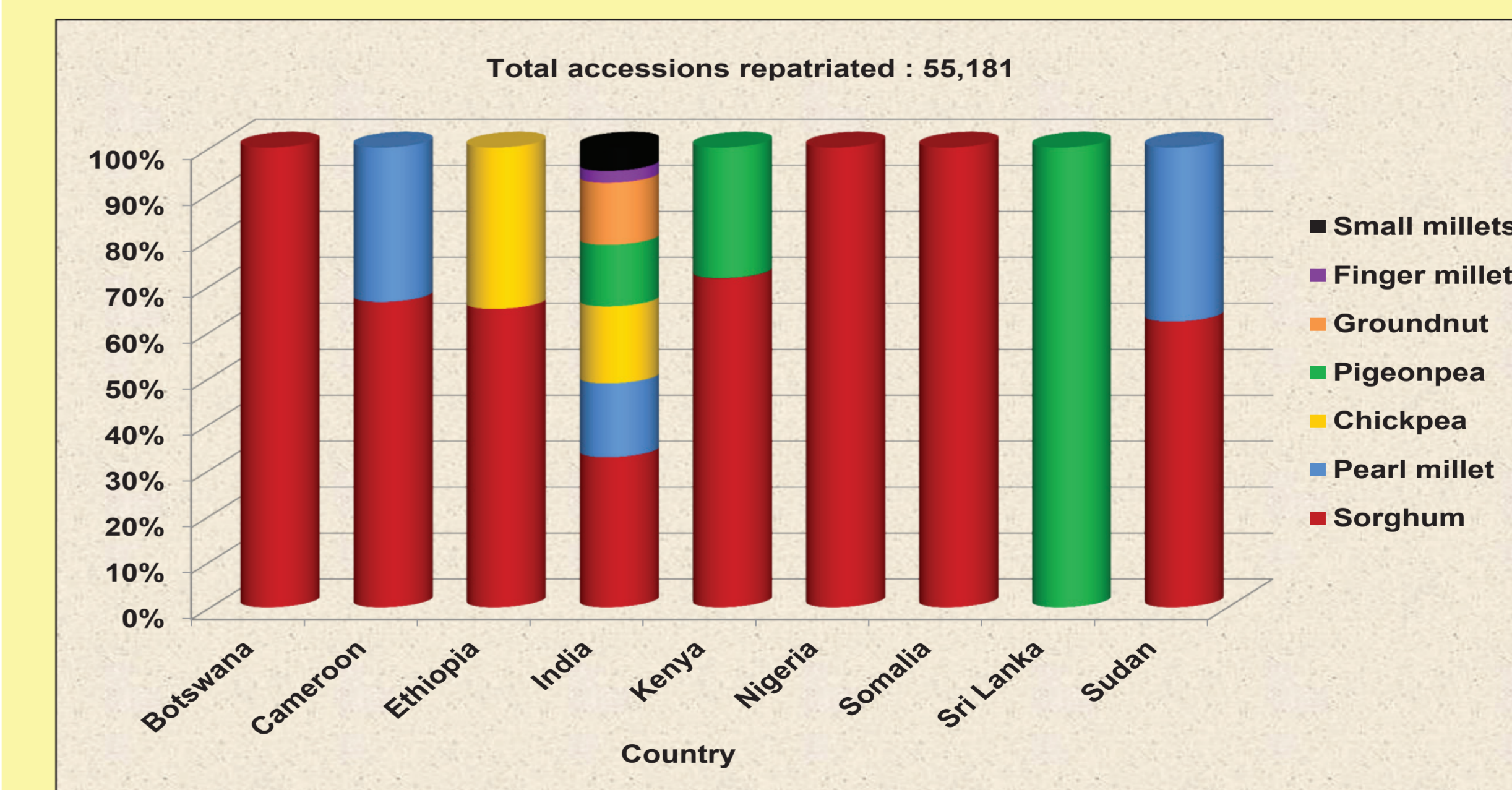
Crop-wise germplasm samples supplied within ICRISAT.

Germplasm repatriation

- ❖ The ICRISAT genebank repatriated 55,181 accessions to nine countries where national collections were lost due to natural disasters or due to lack of proper storage facilities.
